

Kaslo was a bustling community of 5,000 residents with gold, silver, and lead mining. The community had a brewery and several saloons. Over the years, industries declined, as did the population of Kaslo.

The Hotel was first built in 1893, fell into disrepair and closed in the 1920's, and then was acquired by the village for non-payment of taxes. It was utilized from 1942 to 1945 as accommodations for Japanese-Canadian internees being relocated from western B.C.

At one point, about 200 individuals, including many children, were housed in the deteriorated structure. The hotel burned and was razed in 1950.

A new Kaslo Hotel was constructed and opened in 1958 on the original site overlooking Kootenay Lake. It operated continuously, changing its name to the Mariner Hotel in 1981.

In 2006 the Hotel was completely gutted and reconstructed in a process that took more than 2 years. It reopened to guests in early 2009 as the Kaslo Hotel.
